God has directed CBC to establish this fee structure for tuition and registration. CBC's tuition and registration policy is affordable for the person who values the opportunity to enhance their study of the Word of God.

It is very important that the child of God demonstrates wisdom in handling finances. As faithful servants bearing fruit, we must be diligent to fulfill our responsibilities and commitments. Should you decide to enroll at CBC, you will be expected to keep your commitment concerning the payment arrangements agreed upon by you and CBC. There are several payment plan options available.

### PAYMENT PLANS AND SCHEDULES

(\$30.00 Registration fee due with application)

<b>PLAN A</b>	<b>(10% discount</b> if tuition is paid in full at beginning of classes only).
<b>PLAN B</b>	<b>Pay 50%</b> of full tuition at beginning of 1 <sup>st</sup> semester; remaining 50% due at beginning of 2 <sup>nd</sup> semester.
<b>PLAN C</b>	<b>Monthly installments:</b> Based on cost of elected program and the number of course months.
<b>PLAN D</b>	<b>Weekly installments:</b> Based on the cost of elected program and the number of course weeks. (If more than one class is taken on a weekly basis, the cost will be discounted per class.)
To maintain fairness and good student-staff relationships, we request that no other payment arrangements are requested other than what has been offered.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

**Admission:** Any person of age and desires higher learning and whose life shows evidence of a genuine “born again” experience is eligible for enrollment.

**Absentee Policy:** Students are expected to attend all classes and to arrive on time. Failure to attend more than 80% of any given class during a given semester will result in that student being dropped from that particular class. Arriving more than 15 minutes late to class or leaving more than 15 minutes early will constitute an absence for that particular class.

**Books & Supplies:** Students may be required to purchase reference books, tapes, and/or pamphlets during the course of the school year. All literature may be purchased through Covenant Bookstore & Gift Shop or a local Christian bookstore.

**Tuition Refund:** Students who find it necessary to withdraw within the first two weeks of classes, may be granted a 75% refund. In general, after this two-week time period, no refunds will be granted. However, in extreme cases, students requesting a refund will be considered on a “case by case” basis. This request must be in writing and submitted CBC’s Administration Staff at least two (2) weeks after withdrawal. No refund requests will be considered after this two-week timeframe. Depending upon reason for withdrawal, refund may be denied.

***This policy only refers to students who have elected either Payment Plan A or B. No consideration of refunds will be granted for and other Plan.***

All refunds will be paid by check via U.S. mail, within two weeks after written request is submitted to Administration. The above refund policy applies to tuition paid in full. Refunds for those on installment plans will be calculated accordingly.

**Payment Delinquency:** Students substantially delinquent with tuition payments will be notified accordingly. Failure to bring account current in a timely manner may result in endangerment of being dropped from classes.

## ABOUT THE FOUNDER AND PRESIDENT OF CBC

Covenant Bible College is a subsidiary of **Covenant (Brit) Ministries, Inc.**, which is lead by Dr. Levi Webb, Sr., who is the ministry's Pastor and Founder.

In 1976, Levi Webb started sharing the Good News of our Lord and Savior each and every day. For two (2) years, he worked arduously to lead people to a personal relationship with our Lord, fulfilling the call to "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." (Matthew 4:19)

In 1978, Levi Webb started out as a teacher of the Word of God; providing practical teaching on how to have victory over life's problems and the works of Satan through the power of God's Word. It was during this period of time that God lead him to start a Bible Study in his home and it grew to the point of standing room only. The Lord also directed him into "doing the work of an Evangelist", teaching in churches in the Baltimore-Metropolitan area and around the country.

In 1979, Minister Levi Webb became a part of Word of Life Fellowship, under the leadership of Pastor Winston C. Monk. Working closely with Pastor Monk for two years, Minister Levi Webb increased his teaching and preaching outreach ministry, and also became a part of the Baltimore City Jail Ministry. During his tenure, the Baltimore City Jail Ministry grew to over 200 men in attendance each week.

In 1981, the Lord directed Minister Levi Webb to Faith Christian Center, where he worked very closely with the late Pastor Richard W. Phillips. While there, he attended the two-year Zoë Bible Education Program for ministers and laymen. He also excelled as a teacher working in various ministry departments at Faith Christian Center.

In April of 1985, Minister Levi Webb stepped into fulfilling the calling that God had placed on his life nine (9) years prior; that calling was to serve the Lord as a Pastor. God the Father has blessed Dr. Webb with a family-oriented, growing church called Br'it Congregation a.k.a Covenant (Br'it) Ministries, Inc., located at 434-436 Eastern Boulevard in the Baltimore County/Essex area of the State of Maryland. The church is committed to the Word of God, standing firm in the faith and growing in God's Love.

Dr. Webb received his Doctor of Theology from the Kentucky College of Contemporary Religion. He is the author of many books (and other printed material), and has produced numerous Biblical education materials, including sermons, preaching series and seminars on audiocassette tape and videotape.

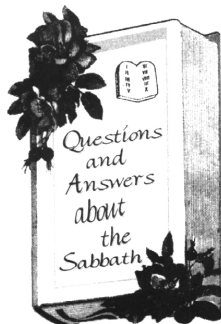
